

Vinte announces the results of the Pre-emptive Subscription and approval of an additional investment from the French Development Financial Institution

Mexico City, Mexico, June 19th, 2019 – Vinte Viviendas Integrales S.A.B. de C.V. (“Vinte”) (BMV: VINTE), informs the investing public that, derived from the end of the Pre-emptive Subscription Period for up to 12,867,648 common, nominative, single series, no-par value shares (the "New Shares"), carried out with the purpose of increasing Vinte’s variable capital stock by up to \$350,000,025.60, as authorized by the Company’s Annual General Meeting held on April 30th, 2019 (the "Meeting"), the following results were obtained:

- Vinte’s current shareholders subscribed 578,764 New Shares, thus, 12,288,884 new shares were unsubscribed (the "New Remaining Shares").
- Consequently and as approved by the Meeting, the New Remaining Shares were offered by Vinte’s Board of Directors to the French Development Financial Institution "Proparco", a subsidiary of the French Development Agency (*Agence Française de Développement - AFD*) focused on private sector development, which had previously expressed its interest in subscribing such shares. This way, on June 18th, Proparco fully subscribed the New Remaining Shares, at the same price they were offered to Vinte’s shareholders (\$27.20 Mexican pesos per share), equivalent to \$334,257,644.80, payable in the same term granted to Vinte’s shareholders.
