Vinte Participates in the Environmental Finance Sustainable Debt Americas Conference 2025 in New York

On September 18, Vinte participated in the Conference held by *Environmental Finance* in New York on Sustainable Debt in America.

The main topics were labeled bonds and loans, that is, those with green, social, sustainable or sustainability-linked labels, as well as how they can accelerate the transition to a global net-zero carbon economy and how to ensure the integrity and credibility of the labeled transactions market.

The conference was held in New York and more than 250 companies from more than 10 countries participated.

Gonzalo Pizzuto, IRO, spoke on the closing panel on *Resilience and Climate Adaptation: Finding a Home and Growth in Sustainable Bonds*. This demonstrates Vinte's commitment to investments with a positive environmental impact.

Vinte's participation in the panel is the result of our commitment, from our sustainable communities to the group's financing, which to date has included 8 labeled bonds: 6 sustainable bonds, of which 3 are also linked to the UN Sustainable Development Goals and two green bonds. In addition, as of June 30, 78% of our financing is classified as sustainable.

Additionally, as a result of Vinte's efforts in sustainable financing, *Environmental Finance* has awarded Vinte's financing on 3 occasions, VINTE 23X SDG as *Social Project Bond of the Year*; VINTE 24X SDG as *Sustainable Bond of the Year – Corporate* and IFC financing for the acquisition of Javer as *Sustainability-Linked Loan of the Year – Corporate (Americas)*.
