Vinte presents its impact investment model of more than 400 million dollars per year at the GIIN Impact Forum 2025 in Berlin.

On October 7, 8 and 9, Vinte was present at the most relevant event on impact investing in the world, the GIIN Impact Forum 2025 in Berlin.

More than 400 institutions participated in the forum, mainly investors with an impact approach, that is, their investments have a positive and measurable influence on social and environmental issues.

Domingo Valdés Díaz, CFO and member of the Board attended the forum, to present the Vinte Sustainable Business Model, with an impact on 14 of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals. Vinte has participated in the forum since 2019, where the team meets with investors and participates in conversations on climate change, leadership in thematic financing, sustainable transformation solutions, among other topics.

Vinte makes annual impact investments of more than 400 million dollars, of which 100 million dollars are through the construction of schools, water treatment plants, rainwater harvesting systems, clinics and road infrastructure for its communities; and 300 million dollars in housing construction, much of it with EDGE certification, which achieve energy savings of 35% and savings in water use of 40%. The group has certified more than 23 thousand EDGE homes, achieving savings equivalent to more than 27 thousand tons of CO₂ and more than 1.4 million m³ of water.
